

Transfer Contract Curricular Requirements

Listed below are the curricular requirements for the transfer contract. For some of the requirements, you will see a list of courses at your school that satisfy the requirement. For the other requirements, you will want to choose a course in the appropriate field of study. Use the Transfer Information System (TIS) at http://tis.uwsa.edu to verify that the courses you choose satisfy the requirement. Click on the "Course Wizard" in TIS, select your school and department, and look for the GenEd symbols identified for each of the course requirements below.

Communication Part A (3 credits) TIS GenEd: 'COM A' Quantitative Reasoning	An English course that focuses on expository writing and speaking, argumentation, and critical reading, and requires a research project using library resources. Ethnic Studies (3 credits) TIS GenEd: 'ETHNIC'	A course that studies the culture and contributions of a persistently marginalized racial or ethnic group in the United States. Literature (3 credits) TIS GenEd: 'L'	Any three-credit literature course will satisfy this requirement.	
Humanities (3 credits) TIS GenEd: 'H' or 'Z'	A course that studies human endeavors in the arts (e.g., history, literature, music, philosophy, religious studies, etc.).	
Social Studies (3 credits) TIS GenEd: 'S,' 'W,' or 'Z'	A course that studies humans in their social relations (e.g., sociology, geography, economics, political science, psychology, etc.).	
Physical Science (3 credits) TIS GenEd: 'P'	A course that studies the physical world (e.g., astronomy, earth science, chemistry, physics, geology, weather and climate, etc.).	
Biological Science (3 credits) TIS GenEd: 'B'	A course that studies the life sciences (e.g., anatomy, physiology, biology, botany, bacteriology, genetics, etc.).
