## Building Systems 2 BAS-141 Work/Life Experience Portfolio

Credit for Prior Learning provides students a range of options to earn college credit for what they already know. Students can demonstrate college-level knowledge and competencies from examination, portfolio, to workforce and military.

## 1. Course title, number & credit value:

Building Systems 2, BAS-141, 2 credits

## 2. Course description:

Course examines building lighting, alarms, security, network access & building envelope systems. Learners will apply course concepts to the JCI Metasys® system extended architecture for managing building operations.

## 3. Course Competencies that must be demonstrated:

- 1. Examine lighting systems and their impact on systems and buildings
- 2. Explore building alarm systems
- 3. Examine security and access systems
- 4. Compare building envelope systems
- 5. Troubleshoot building systems
  - 4. Portfolio requirements that demonstrate competencies.

    \*Note for Resumes: Lead faculty must verify the student's work history via a letterhead mail or phone interview.

Document experience in a paragraph or two for each for competency listed. Provide verifying documentation such as a letter from the employer (supervisor) validating the experience for each competency. Note, that just as with grades in a course, you may not have in depth back ground for each competency. So just because your experience does not line up literally with a competency, does not mean you will not meet the competency . So document what you do have and submit.
