WEBDEV-198 Internship Course, 1 credit Work/Life Experience Portfolio

Credit for Prior Learning provides students a range of options to earn college credit for what they already know. Students can demonstrate college-level knowledge and competencies from examination, portfolio, to workforce and military.

1. Provide the course description & competencies:

This course focuses on a personal marketing plan and branding of skills and experience as a WebDesigner, Developer and Project Manager. This course focuses on the observation and application of the principles and techniques of web design and development as studied in the Web and Digital Media Program, through an internship.

The Internship must be geared towards a career in Web and Digital Media Design. Students are to explore the concepts of User Interaction and User Experience also known as UI/UX, as these concepts are essential to the overall website functionality. Experience or observe the skills and techniques to accomplish the goals of a project through real word interaction with team members and clients.

- 2. Portfolio requirements needed to demonstrate the competencies.

 - Work resume (with either a letterhead mail or phone interview)
 - An interview with the lead faculty member to review work experience
