- Prerequisite courses (except science courses) with grades of C or higher
- Science courses with B- or higher: BIOSCI-177 & BIOSCI-179 (or BIOSCI-201 & BIOSCI-202), BIOSCI-197, and CHEM-186 (or CHEM-207 & CHEM-208)
- Cumulative GPA of 2.5
- Entrance Exam: HESI (minimum score of 900) (3 lifetime attempts) www.matchealth.com
