

Partners in College: Liberal Arts Collaborative Agreement

Students from most Wisconsin Technical Colleges (WTC) can seamlessly transfer up to 30 selected General Studies credits (100-level) with the intent of completing their Associate in Arts or Associate in Science degree at:

- Madison Area Technical College
- Milwaukee Area Technical College
- Nicolet Area Technical College

Students now may complete the 64-credit program at one of these three participating WTCs with extensive Liberal Arts and Sciences course offerings, including 200-level (four-year college transfer) classes.

While most four-year colleges accept some 100-level courses for credit transfer, virtually all four-year colleges accept 200-level classes.

Many students transfer A.A. and A.S. degree credits to four-year colleges as the first two years of a bachelor's degree program.

The A.A. degree emphasizes social science and humanities; the A.S. degree focuses on math and natural sciences. Both degrees are for students who seek a broad educational background.

REQUIRED STEPS

- Select one of these participating Wisconsin Technical College System schools to attend: Blackhawk, Chippewa Valley, Fox Valley, Gateway, Indianhead, Lakeshore, Midstate, Moraine Park, Northcentral, Northeast, Southwest, Waukesha County or Western.
- Complete a WTCs admission application for MATC Madison, MATC Milwaukee or Nicolet, indicating your intent to pursue a Liberal Arts degree.
- Complete and sign the Liberal Arts Collaborative Agreement Application and submit to your academic advisor before completing 12 general education credits.
- Meet with an MATC Madison, MATC Milwaukee or Nicolet program advisor (in person or by phone) at least once per semester.
- Enroll in required transfer agreement courses (see reverse) and maintain a minimum 2.0 grade-point average.
- Contact the MATC Madison, MATC Milwaukee or Nicolet Liberal Arts program advisor at least eight weeks before the start of the transfer semester.
